## Explanation of Membership Types

1. *Full Membership:*

Active members are required, as of this printing, will be required to run duty, as assigned, the equivalent of 12 hours each week or 48 hours per month. After investigation of this application, you will be voted on for Temporary Membership, which lasts 60 days. After the Temporary period has been completed, your application will be voted on for Full Membership, which gives you voting privileges, eligibility to hold an elected office in accordance with the Bylaws, and Life Membership after 10 years of Active service. Applicants without any EMS certifications are required to become certified as an "Emergency Vehicle Operator" with "CPR" within 6 months of joining the Squad or "Emergency Medical Technician" within 16 months of joining the Squad, and must abide by all rules and regulations of the Squad.

2. *Special Membership:*

Special members are required, as of this printing, will be required to run duty, as assigned, the equivalent of 12 hours each month. Special Members are not given voting privileges, cannot hold an elected office in accordance with the Bylaws, and are not entitled to Life Membership. Special Members must be a member of another fire department, rescue squad, law enforcement agency, or emergency communications center, are certified as an "Emergency Vehicle Operator" with "CPR" or an "Emergency Medical Technician", and must abide by all rules and regulations of the squad.

3. *Associate Membership:*

Associate members are "non call-running" members that wish to contribute to the various functions of the Squad. Associate members are not given voting privileges and cannot act as an agent of the Squad or hold an elected office, other than those set forth in the Bylaws. Associate members are not entitled to Life Membership and must abide by all rules and regulations of the Squad.
